Legal basis of the processing

Art. 6 (1) point b) GDPR Data are collected which are necessary for the pursuit of the association's goals and for the support and administration of its members (such as name, address, as well as bank details, bank code and account number).

<u>Justified interests within the meaning of Art. 6 (1) point f) GDPR</u> A collection of data for purposes other than those mentioned above will not be carried out.

Officials of the association and their business contact data are published on the internet on the websites of the association. Personal data of other members of the association are only transferred or published with the explicit consent. Data is not transferred to third countries.

We point out that each person has the right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, as well as to object to the processing of their personal data. The statutory storage period is adhered to.

Each person has the right to complain to a supervisory authority.

The consent can be revoked at any time.
